COVID UPDATES - Important notices to keep our community safe

Face Coverings

As you are already aware, due to the rising level of Covid-19 in Bristol, we are now requiring everyone to wear a face covering in communal areas. Face coverings are not worn in the classroom, to aid speaking and comprehension. However, if your child wishes to wear a face mask in class, they can.

Over half term, please make sure your child has enough masks for the week. We request that students have washable, reusable, appropriate cloth face coverings, as these are best for the environment. Ideally, have enough so that these can be washed regularly. You will probably need 5 face masks and bags (one for every day of the week) so that you have time to wash them. If purchasing face coverings is a financial problem or you have a health condition that means you cannot wear one, please contact the school by emailing admin@bristolfreeschool.org.uk

If your child arrives at School having forgotten to pack one, they should report to Student Services immediately.

Please watch this film that goes through how to wear a face mask appropriately. Don't presume that you know all this automatically. If masks are used badly, and particularly if they also give a false sense of security, they can make things worse.

Covid Symptoms

If your child develops COVID symptoms over the half term break they need to book a test and the household MUST self-isolate for 14 days.

- If your child has a **negative** test result. The period of self-isolation can stop, as long as anyone else in the household who has symptoms also tests negative.
- If your child has a **positive** test result then your child self-isolates for 10 days from when the symptoms started (or 10 days from the test result if they had no symptoms). The rest of the household must self-isolate for 14 days.
